

General Instructions for submitting the camera-ready paper for the 18th ASONAM 2026 and Collocated Events

In 2026 ASONAM edition, Springer-Nature will handle the proceedings and as a result, different instructions than the previous years should be taken into consideration for the preparation and submission of the camera ready files (pdf and source files) and the copyright form.

Preparations

You must revise your paper by carefully considering all comments from the reviewers. Please remember the following before preparing your camera-ready version of your paper:

- 15 pages for Long papers (includes References and Appendices).
- 8 pages for Short papers (includes References and Appendices).
- The maximum extra-pages allowed are 2 for Long papers, and 2 for Short papers.
- Note that if you need extra-pages, this should be decided at registration time.

The camera-ready must be prepared in Springer format following the next steps.

Step 1: Use Springer-Nature Template for camera ready paper

Depending on the venue that your paper has been accepted follow step 2a or 2b.

Step 3: Upload your paper to the camera-ready submission website

Navigate to the camera-ready submission website: <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ASONAM2026/> (select the track "Proceedings – all papers") and **upload** your paper in the following formats:

- A PDF file
- Source files either in Word format or LaTeX files in a ZIP in the corresponding fields

Step 4: Upload your License to Publish file

When uploading the paper in the camera ready submission site, you will also see the option to upload the copyright form. Please use this field to upload your License to Publish file in PDF format signed by hand.

Step 5: Check if any other changes are required
